



## SPRING FRANKLIN 2021 COVID PLAN

1. The Covid Coverage area will be designated as anything inside the park and all individuals that enter are subject to the Covid Plan.
2. Brian Williams (216-650-0001) will be the liaison for any Covid related questions or issues.
3. Everyone that enters the Covid Area will need to report to the Risk Manager or designee to sign the insurance waiver and have the following health checks:
  - a. Temperature taken and must be below 100.
  - b. Questioned on Covid symptoms and have no symptoms or other illness present.
    - i. If any ailments exist, no admittance will be allowed.
4. The Race Committee is requiring the use of face masks at all times that social distancing cannot be met, especially during Registration, Driver's Meeting, Rescue and Turn judge/ Tow boat duty, Judges Stand and in Inspection. Anyone wearing a full-face helmet is exempt for wearing a face mask.
  - a. Anywhere in the Pit area – if helmet is off, then mask needs to be on.
  - b. Exceptions
    - i. Inside your vehicle or Motor home
    - ii. Outside of vehicle or motorhome
      1. This is your personal zone - must stay within 6 ft of vehicle at all times.
    - iii. Inside your enclosed trailer
    - iv. Outside of trailer
      1. This is your personal zone - must stay within 6 ft of trailer at all times.
5. Rescue, turn boat and Judges Stand personnel are required to wear masks and maintain as much distance as possible.
6. Hand sanitizer will be available, but it is recommended for all teams to bring their own as well.
7. The Race Committee will be responsible for policing the policy. The Race Committee instructions must be followed.
8. Failure to wear a mask will get a warning. Upon further violations, a Yellow card will be issued. Any refusal to comply with Covid Plan or Race Committee's instructions will result in a Red card issued and possible disqualification/ ejection and forfeiture of any entry fees.
9. All the above requirements and conditions are subject to change dependent on current Covid requirements from the state or local Governments at time of event.
