To Whom It May Concern:

The Top O' Michigan Outboard Racing Club (TOMORC) plans on holding a short course and marathon race at the Fireside Inn on June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

As a club, we plan on adhering to all current MDHHS Orders that are in place while holding our race. We will be following the most up to date orders that pertain to us that are in effect on June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>.

Currently, spectators are not allowed in or on the Fireside Inn's property. Spectators are defined as individuals not related to any racer, individuals not staying at the Fireside Inn, and individuals that are not part of a designated pit crew. **We anticipate this changing with the hopeful elimination of outdoor gathering limitations expected on June 1<sup>st</sup>.**

Masks are not required to be worn while outside.

The Fireside Inn may have additional COVID protocol that comes along with running a hospitality business. Should they have additional measures to be followed, we will follow all posted measures that are required when it comes to distancing, dining, cabin rentals, etc. Attendees and racers are required to abide by any and all rules that the Fireside Inn has in place.

Should racers be traveling to our race from outside Northern Michigan – it is expected by TOMORC that should symptoms occur during travel by either the racer or ANY individual of the racers traveling group, that the entire group will report their symptoms, self-quarantine, and NOT participate in any race activities.

We will provide hand sanitizer around various locations.

Registration may be online as well as in person. For the in person portion, social distancing will be in place along with additional sanitizing methods. We ask that all racers adhere to social distancing guidelines. Additionally, a handout will be distributed out at registration detailing drivers meeting times, safety expectations, FAQ, and additional material.

Our operations will be consistent with limitations implemented by the current MDHHS orders.
