APBA COVID SAFETY PROTOCOL

1. Upon entering the pits, all participants will be required to complete a health survey. Signage shall be posted stating mask requirements and social distancing standards be upheld.

Public restrooms will have hand sanitizing stations and shall be sanitized every hour.

No food or beverage services are provided at this event. There are no applicable camping or RV areas available at this event.

The maximum number of participants allowed in each boat pit area shall not exceed 10 at any one time.

- 4. All participants will be required to wear a face covering and adhere to current CDC requirements for social distancing.
- 5. Hand sanitizing stations will be present at all entrances, registration locations, judge's stand, inspection, and announcing areas. As well as public restrooms.
- 6. All rescue personnel will be required to wear face coverings and distance each other while on the rescue boats. One person shall be designated as the sole boat driver/operator. All rescue boats will have hand sanitizer / wipes on board.
- 7. Based on initial entrance health survey, any participants experiencing any COVID related symptoms, will not be allowed entrance into the event.
- 8. A cautionary notice/warning will be verbally expressed to all participants and signage posted at the event entrance.
- 9. Announcements and reminders to practice social distancing, mask requirements, and hand sanitizing will be made every hour.
