




INBOARD CHAIRPERSON CANDIDATE - 2026

Decatur, IL and Celina, OH have re-established themselves as top sites for Inboard Racing. These provide the model for new events in the works.

We have also formed solid connections with H1 and their race sites to bring better Inboard Hydroplane Racing classes to compliment the big boys. These relationships are growing stronger by the day and will continue into the future.
