A sanction committee will be reinstated in 2020 to evaluate and approve sanctions. Dan Joseph, Jay Marshall, Doug Brow, Jed Wolcott, and Mark Cravens will comprise the committee.

The promotional fund committee for 2020 will be comprised of John Krebs, Shaun Kelson, Dan Joseph, Jay Marshall, and Rayner Blair.

Jay Marshall has been assigned to organize V&H awards for 2020. An email award requesting nominations will be sent out to region reps.

Krebs asked that organizers planning events for 2020 submit their dates to him as soon as possible for consideration at the national meeting.

John Krebs, Doug Brow, Jay Marshall, John Woodward, Bob Moore, Shaun Kelson, Dick Delsener, JP Squires, Dan and Debbie Joseph, and possibly Jack Meyer will be attending the national meeting in Seattle. The V&H meeting will take place from 8:00 AM – 9:30 AM on Saturday January 25. The vintage gathering will take place from 5 – 9 on Friday January 24 at the Kelson shop in Seattle. Group transportation to the vintage gathering from the hotel is being worked out.

Jeff Buckley requested discussion on physicals for riding mechanics in V&H, and the enforcement of the requirement for eyewear. Current V&H bylaws do not require physicals for riding mechanics. This issue will be discussed and possible changes to the bylaws made at next week's conference call. Referees will be instructed to enforce current eyewear requirements.

The APBA inboard rule requiring slings to be recertified or replaced every 2 years is being reviewed and may be extended to 5 years. V&H will likely adopt this new rule if inboard passes it.

The next conference call will be Wednesday, January 15 at 8:30 PM.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 PM on motion of Donnie McLean, seconded by Jack Meyer.
